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

convened a crucial meeting with private sector stakeholders, business leaders, and the Kenya National Chambers of Commerce and Industry (KNCCI) – Embu chapter, to discuss strategies for sustainable urban growth and enhanced donor engagement.

The discussions focused on the private sector engagement framework, identified as vital for attracting donor support. CECM Raymond Kinyua updated participants on the progress of chartering new municipalities, noting, "An ad-hoc committee to spearhead the process has been appointed by the Cabinet Secretary for Lands and is just awaiting gazettment."


Governor Mbarire emphasized the importance of proactive planning, stating, "The future is urban, and we must prepare in time to avoid social pressures in our growing towns."

Participants also highlighted the role of automation and reliable data in managing various sectors efficiently, underscoring the county's commitment to forging partnerships that support orderly urban development and economic growth.

**Minute 1/19/12/25 Introduction**

The meeting started at 9:30 am with prayers led by Director for Urban Development.

The Municipal Manager gave the opening remarks, introducing the subject and the agenda of the day. She also led the participants through the introductions and read the CECM’s opening remarks.

**Minute 2/19/12/25 Development of the ISUDP**

The physical planners explained that the ISUDP expired technically due to change of law to 10 years. Hence the necessity to have another one irrespective of the former being up to 2035.

She took the participants through the background for planning the Municipality for purposes of spatial plan development and the benefits of doing so. They were introduced to the metamorphosis of Embu town through its life to the current existing Municipality of Embu. The Planners delved into the current needs arising from the outlay of the developments, activities and social economic activities within the Municipality.

### **The participants raised the following issues and challenges in planning**

#### **Water & sanitation**

- i) Safety and security of Kariari in Dallas
- ii) There is need to have a public toilet near the EWASCO or Municipal hall
- iii) There need to have two public toilets in the upper side of the town
- iv) The sewerage transferred to a different place

#### **Environment safety**

- i) Njukiri forest should be fenced with electric fence for increased forest cover and improved security

#### **Markets and Bus Terminus**

- i) Market next to new Kenstar to host miraa market in future after completion of the new market.
- ii) Shauri slum to be relocated so that their place could be occupied by the Meru Stage
- iii) To decongest the town, the market in majimbo should be revamped for use.
- iv) The peripheral suburbs of the town should be developed for growth; such as Gakwegori and Karurina. Identification of areas for expansion of business should be done eg towards Kiritiri and Njukiri areas
- v) The space for KALRO and KARI and hospital be moved to Njukiri to free the space for further development such as a Mall
- vi) Expansion could be done through the Kanjuru road instead of Kaunda street
- vii) The Municipality could have CSR provision for other upcoming urban areas.
- viii) The upper side of town is not served by any terminus. Some parking lots should be designated for stage; e.g. EMCO to do like tea room to service for public stage on the upper side.
- ix) Embu town should be encouraged to have a 24-hour economy.
- x) There should be designated smoking zones for Embu due to careless smoking. A Rehabilitation should be done for reforms

#### **Road**

- i) There is need a climbing lane from Kirinyaga bridge to Kirimari Petrol station; to ease motor vehicle traffic congestion
- ii) Upon provision of the exit to Kianjokoma stage congested was resolved. However, there is need to solve the congestion caused by the supermarket. This will improve the security of pedestrians. We need to address a roundabout in Embu for decongestion. The area around Magunandu to Dallas area and towards kabingazi river we should have a six lane for decongestion.  
There should be erected bumps in the same area and next to nice hardware and foot bridge to ensure safety of pedestrian

- iii) Due to the congestion in town, where will the dual carriage pass through?
- iv) The renewal of leases should be restricted to the areas which will not be affected by demolition in case of the dual carriage and bypasses. This will allow for expansion without compensation.
- v) We need to have clear roads, unlike the shoe shiners who came in after Shakahola traders were moved.
- vi) The open trench opposite Meru stage, adjacent to Shanyaki should be covered as it is hazardous and has been turned into a waste dumping place.
- vii) Water runoff should be managed well in Dallas as it has been affected by developments that are blocking water flow in addition to cut away soil dumping.
- viii) Dallas primary school to have a bridge linking to Kiritiri highway for the safety of the pupils
- ix) The Section towards Koimugo -Njukiri estate to be redone as it has become a disaster for the medical staff who reside there.
- x) The roadside from the University of Embu to Kangaru should have a foot path and proper Lighting to improve security of the students.
- xi) The bypass GTI-Kamiu-Majimbo road should be tarmacked for a bypass
- xii) Njukiri tarmac road should be redone

### **Housing**

- i) The Governor's residence was misplaced and should be used for a different purpose while a different place is sought for Governor's residence
- ii) Kaunda street houses should be redone to create more space to decongest the town. This will free space for more development

### **Funding**

- i) Through the Public representative groups a memorandum to the County Assembly and the GVN's office could be done or even through the liaison committee to push for allocation of more resources to the Municipality.

### **Development safety**

- i) Building development control and inspection should be done well and material testing using Newtons per Cubic Millimeter using a scheming hammer to avoid collapsing of buildings.
- ii) Other views were recorded by the physical planner for ISUDP notes

### **Minute 3/19/12/25 Demarcation of the Municipality**

- Director survey took the participants through the demarcation process for urban development, for prevention of disputes and conflicts, for resource management and environment protection.
- He cited the Constitution of Kenya, Urban Areas and Cities Act, the County Government Act for authority to demarcate. The Survey Acts too.
- The fixing of the Boundary is thus very critical. He took the Meeting through the current map about 25,000 acres.
- The delineation was done by description but the demarcation with beacons was yet to be done.

**Resolutions of Demarcation:**

The alignment of the boundary curves will be done on ground.

**Minute 4/19/12/25 CRP**

- The Environment officer presented the necessity and foundation of the Climate Risk Profile (CRP).
- The CRP is necessary for planning development, identify vulnerable sectors, guide resilience, support financing; climate financing.
- The CRP Informs sensitivity, exposure, vulnerability and adaptive capacity.
- The participants discussed the common hazards within the Municipality, prioritizing on the Pluvial, Fluvial and drought hazards in the CRP.
- The document will be in use for the next 10 years.
- There was emphasis that it was important to match the planning with risks to inform development.
- The information of CRP will be available in the Municipal website.

**Solutions for CRP**

- i) There should be redesigning of the drainage system
- ii) There will be integration of storm water into all planning
- iii) There shall be a waste management plan from source to disposal
- iv) There shall be a public campaign on waste management

The Public forum closed with prayers by Dr. Kathii after vote of thanks, will the Vice Chair prayed for refreshments at 3:10 PM.





