The participants were then welcomed to the meeting by The Chief Officer in charge of Urban Development who thereafter welcomed the Municipal Manager to expound more on the agenda of the meeting.

Members were taken through the origin and establishment of the Municipality and the categories of Urban Areas by The Municipal Manager and listed down the below;

- A. The Municipality emanates from Mutunduri, Camp Nduda and Gachoka.
- B. The Municipality is presided over by a Municipal Board as enlisted in the Urban Areas and Cities Act and the responsibilities of the Board are limited to the dominion of the Municipalities.
- C. A handful of attributes were put into consideration with population being among them and that all County headquarters would transition to Municipalities.
- D. Embu County did not attain the caliber to have a municipality but was given the Municipality of Embu on the rider of Embu Town being a county headquarter.
- E. The constitution section 184 allowed by the parliament to enact legislation for classification and management of Urban Areas.
- F. The above Therefore brought forth the Urban Areas and Cities Act (UACA) that classifies urban areas into Cities, Municipalities, Towns and Markets.
- G. In order to institutionalize the Municipalities, the World Bank has funded all Municipalities through the National Government. This fund was pegged on the population as at 2009.
- H. The County Government has transferred functions to the Municipality including;
 - Municipal administration services including leasing, construction and maintenance of offices
 - Collection of parking fees, advertising and environmental taxes within the municipality
 - Construction, maintenance and regulation of Municipal markets
 - Control and management of hawking activities within the Municipality
 - Provision of GIS services
 - Development of Municipal by-laws

- Construction and maintenance of recreational parks, green spaces and social halls
- Providing public water points and maintenance of storm drainage and flood controls
- Regulation and control of outdoor advertising
- Construction and maintenance of bus parks and tax stands
- Construction, maintenance and regulation of traffic controls and parking facilities
- Promotion, regulation and provision of refuse collection and solid waste management services within the Municipality
- Construction and maintaining public toilets within the Municipality
- Construction and maintenance of feeder roads and walkways within the Municipality
- Installation and maintenance of street lights and flood lights
- Construction and maintenance of fire stations; provision of firefighting services, emergencies preparedness and disaster management
- Development and enforcement of Municipal plans and development controls

MIN NO: MOE/BOARD/PUBLIC FORUM: /04/2024/2025: : PRESENTATION OF THE KUSP2 DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME AND STAKEHOLDERS PROPOSAL FOR THE PROJECTS THAT THE MUNICIPALITY MAY IMPLEMENT

The Kenya Urban Support Program 1 had come to a close and the Municipality Management was doing everything within its means to attain the minimum conditions set by the World Bank to qualify for Kenya Urban Support Program 2.

Some of the projects that were implemented previously in KUSP1 are listed below;

- I. Upgrading of Kangaru-Kairuri Road and Upgrading of Old B6 junction (KSG)-Kamui (Part) Road to Bitumen Standards. (1.8KM) – 2018/2020
- II. Paving of parking spaces in Embu Town with Cabro blocks (200 parking slots) – 2018/2020
- III. Rudisho- Mutunduri-Ngugi wa Iria Road to Bitumen Standards (2KM) -2019/2020
- IV. Paving of parking spaces in Embu Town (200 parking slots) – 2019/2020
- V. Embu- Runyenjes Bus Park- 2020/221
- VI. Kubukubu Walkway – 2020/2021
- VII. Façade 2020/2021

VIII. Market stalls at Embu- Runyenjes stage – 2023/2024

The stakeholders were informed that preparation for KUSP II program was in high gear and that the municipality was expecting funding to implement the projects that had been agreed upon during the previous forum, namely, Cabro paving of Kamuketha – WINAS Street and Catholic Bookshop – Dubai Curtains street and the associated street furniture. The proposed Cabro Paving project would help with the ease of movement, parking and running of businesses for the public. It was also reiterated that the project would not result in displacement of persons since it would follow the existing alignments.

The residents proposed the following projects that the Municipality can implement:

1. Tarmacking of feeder roads.
2. Provision of water points and rest places.
3. Painting of buildings in one colour code.
4. Landscaping along the highway to prevent growth of unwanted scrub.
5. Enhancing fire and disaster management.
6. Lighting backstreets to prevent insecurity and encourage opening up of businesses in the areas.
7. Controlling and investing in adverts and posters.
8. Provision of clean toilets.

Investing in garbage, waste collection and disposal

MIN NO: MOE/BOARD/PUBLIC FORUM /05/2024/2025: : RESIDENTS COMMENTS

The chair of the meeting allowed participants to give their views. Participants were given the opportunity to use any language that one is conversant with and is most suitable for them to express their opinions and concerns on the same.

Some of the views raised by the participants were as follows;

- Proper measures should be brought up about the proper planning of the town.
- Backstreets should be paved with Cabro blocks to encourage people to carry out businesses in those areas.
- The beautification of town should be a top priority through engaging the business owners, hotels, banks to participate in landscaping and greening.

- Waste management was a source of revenue that the municipality was not looking into.
- Reorganization of transport network in the municipality to prevent traffic jam.
- Addition of value could be done to waste via Jua Kali sectors.
- Prioritization of the completion of roads that were to be partially tarmacked.
- Acceleration of full transfer of functions to the municipality.
- Individuals who have installed kiosks on parking spaces to be requested to vacate from the spaces.
- Waste management would become a menace in town and estates and the municipality should embark on investing heavily on it.

5. Upgrading of corridors in CBD
